Extraordinary Vintage Pens

1	Four-Way	1925	Double-nibbed bulb-filler in Green Marble. CPT. Extremely rare pen, accommodating two colors of ink at the same time. The lower nib assembly, which unscrews from the barrel, reverses and then screws back into the barrel for use, has a red bottom insert to show the expected color of the ink used. The cap screws onto either end. Shown both open and closed, so all the parts can be seen. Near mint.	\$1750
2	Omas	1930	Itala Double-nibbed pen in Red Marble. As rare as is the "Colorado" below, the Itala is 50 times rarer! The mechanism is spring and cam driven; pulling down the blind cap on the bottom of the pen changes repels one nib and retracts the other. You can't begin to imagine how rare it is to also have an example, such as this one, which still operates perfectly! Fine, flexible nibs. New-old-stock. Mint.	\$9000
3	Omas	1945	Colorado double-barreled, double nibbed PIF in Black with "scissor" barrel configuration. NPT. Red dot & white dot on gripping sections so you know which side has which color ink. Incredible pen, almost never found in this condition. Shown open and closed. New-old-stock. Mint	\$2300
4	Pan	1930	Double-nibbed BF pen in Green Marble. Pan is a little known German manufacturer of high quality pens which are extremely rare today. Finding a double-nibbed Pan has been unheard of up until now. A red casein band on one side helps avoid confusion regarding which side has which color ink. Shown both open and closed, so all the parts can be seen. Broad, extra-flexible, italic nibs. Near mint.	\$2950
5	Parker	1910	Model 47 Eyedropper-fill. One of the most beautiful of the early Parker pens. Nicknamed the "Pregnant Parker," because of the bulbous design of the alternating pearl and abalone slabs (which are soaked until soft so they can be so shaped). Gold-filled high relief repousse floral cap and barrel bands. Indicia engraved in beautiful Script lettering "L.K." or "L.H." Incredibly beautiful! Near mint+	\$5500
6	Parker	1927	Duofold Sr. BF in Mandarin Yellow. GFT. Broad nib. New-old-stock. Mint with a deep, crisp barrel imprint. [Two available, the second with a fine nib]	\$1800



7	Pelikan	1933	100 PIF in Tortoise. Very rare model with 2-piece blind cap. Clip can be adjusted to convert the pen to the rare "long cap" model, sold in the Swiss market. The cap imprint is along the edge of the upper portion. Amber celluloid visualated barrel. Broad, flexible, italic nib (other nibs available). Near mint+ (could be new-old-stock).]	\$2200
8	Pelikan	1937	111 PIF in 14K Solid Gold barrel overlay. Rare overlay pattern: alternating panels of wide engine turning, narrow plain and pinstripes. Green acrylic visualated barrel. Black cap with GFT. New-old-stock. Mint in original box.	\$3000
9	Meteor/ Pullman	1932	Pullman 35 Meteor BF in BCHR. Incredible pen, where the nib propels and retracts by pushing and pulling the barrel of the pen into and out of the cap. Not many survived, as they broke when folks tried to screw off the cap. Pullman (UK) licenced the technology to the La Plume D'Or company in France, who called their version the Meteor. Fine nib. New-old-stock. Mint.	\$2250
10	Pullman	1932	Pullman BF in Gold-filled. Alternating wave chased engine-turned and plain panels. Fully engine-turned geometric design on the top 5/8" of the cap. The nib propels and retracts by pushing the barrel up into the cap. Extremely rare, especially in an all metal version. Fine nib "Paris D & D 18 ct." "D & D" stands for Demely & Degan, founders of the company. Near mint.	\$3750
11	Montblanc	1930	30 Masterpiece Push-knob Set in Coral Red. GFT. Fine, flexible, italic nib. Near mint in original box. An absolutely wonderful and extremely rare set!	\$2500
12	Montblanc	1930	53 "Flair Top" twist-activated pencil for above set. The pencil may be rarer than the pen!	Set
13	Waterman	1920	Prohibition Flask! Extremely rare is an understatement! Made to look exactly like the Model 20 Safety pen (the largest pen in Waterman's model line at the time). Allowed folks to carry booze without being suspected of breaking the law. Complete with perfect barrel imprints and pocket clip. New-old-stock. Mint.	\$4000
14	Waterman	1935	Patrician LF in Jade. GFT. Absolutely mint color! You'll never find one nicer! In the mid-1930's Waterman changed the clip design, consistent with the clips they were using on other of their models at the time. Medium/fine, flexible nib. New-old-stock. Mint.	\$2750

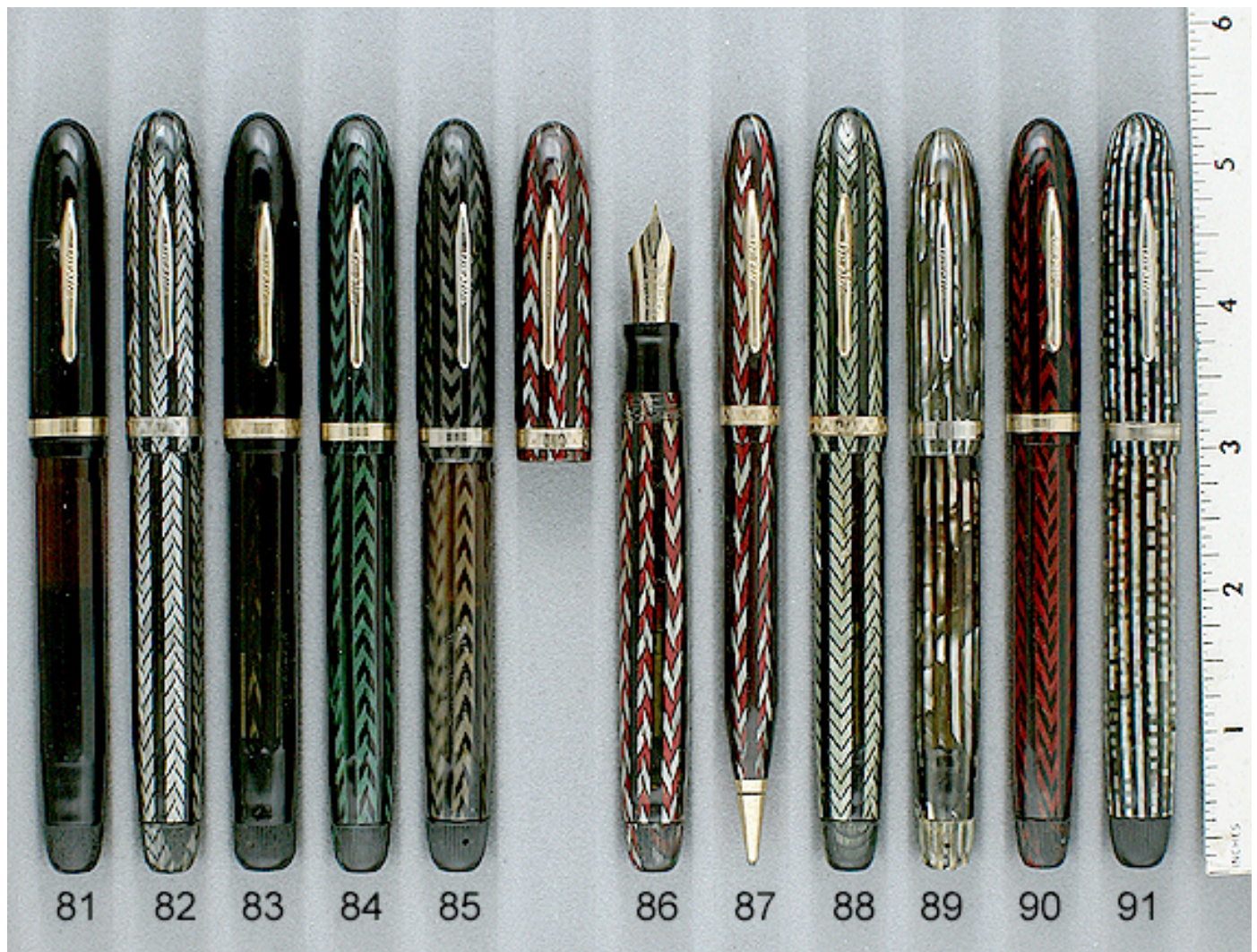

109	Diamond Point	1910	#2 size LF in Black Chased Hard Rubber. NPT. Fine nib. A bit of imprint wear (fully readable) otherwise near mint.	\$100

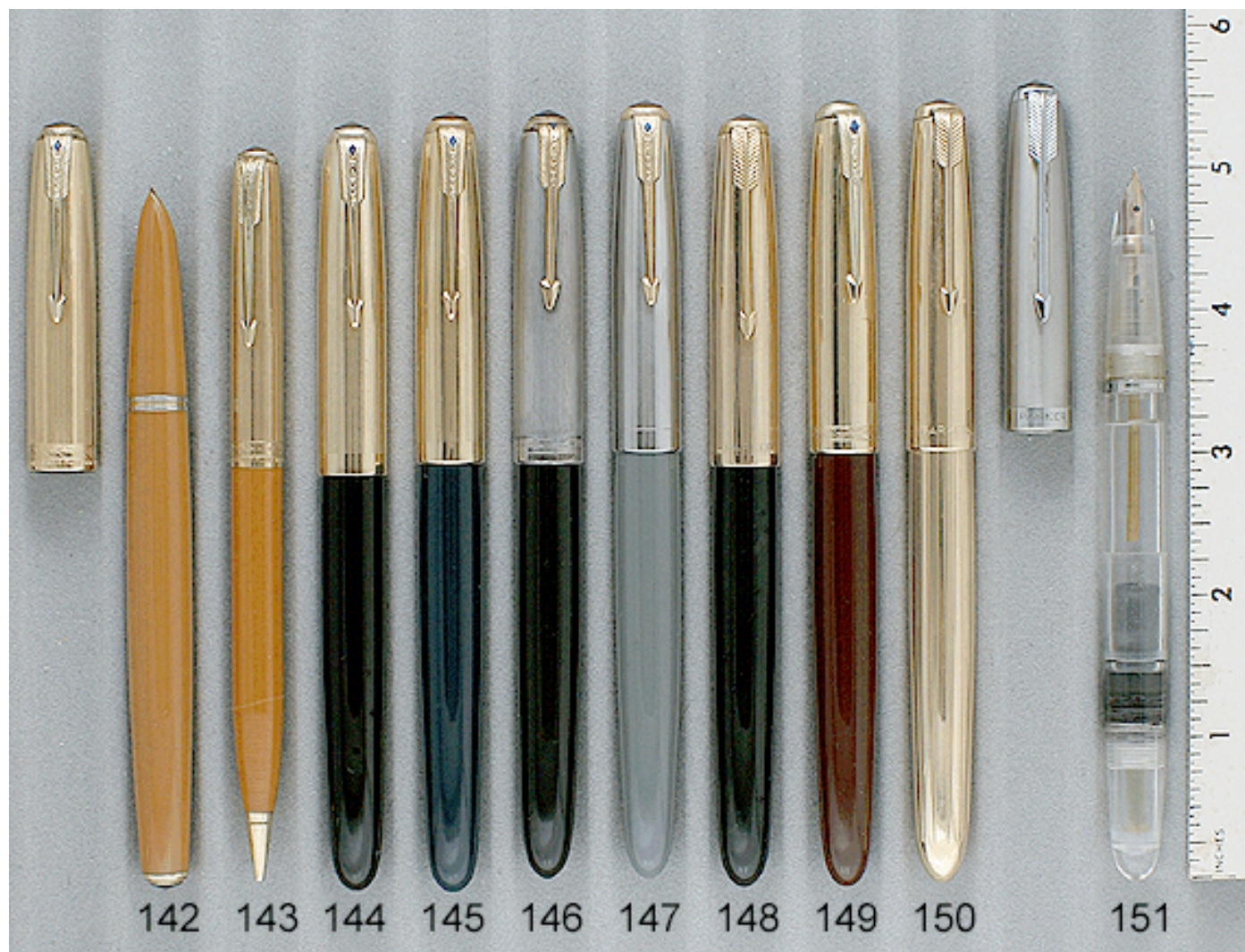

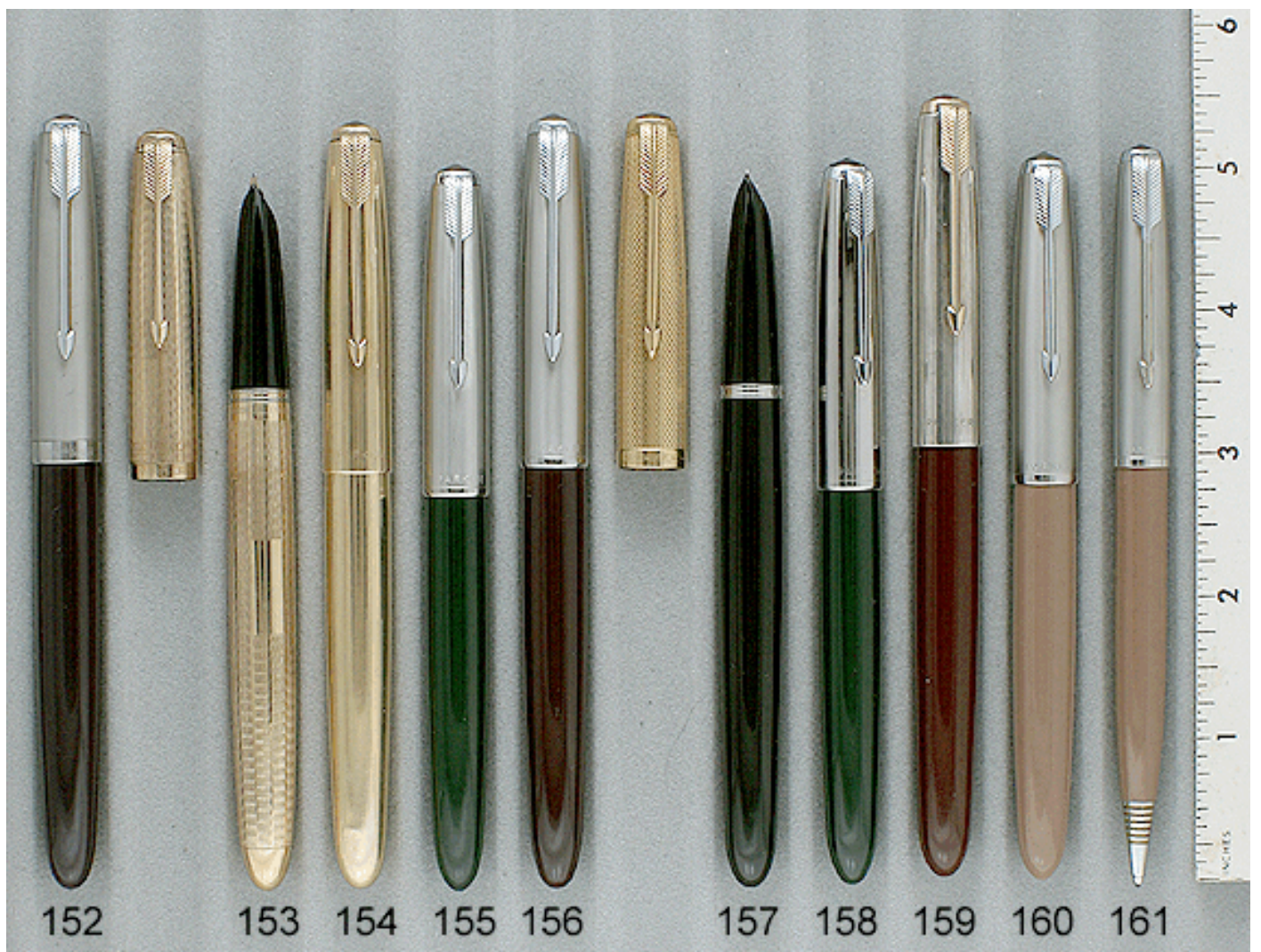

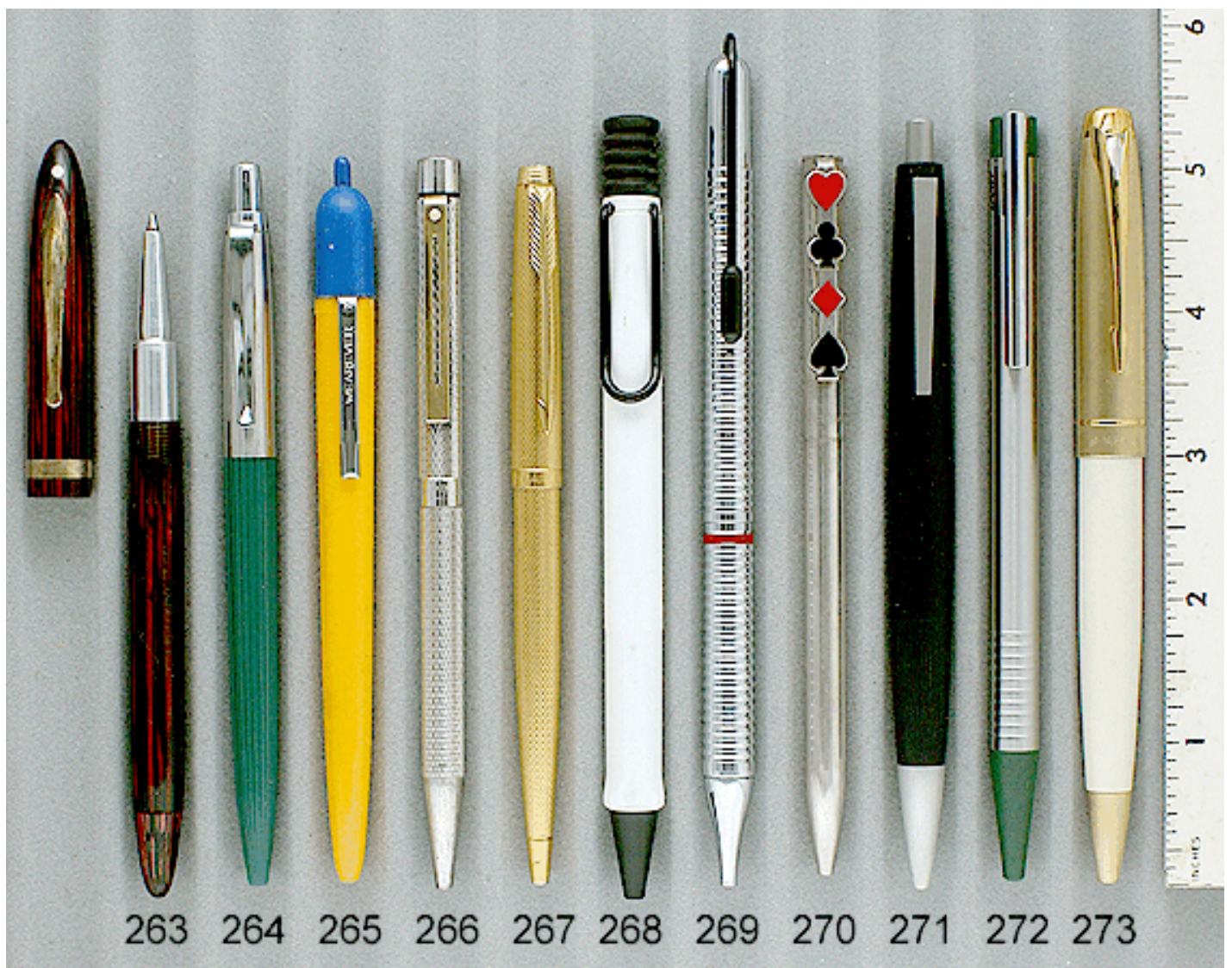
