Parker 45 "Tester" Set

Parker 45 "Tester Set" in Green, Black, Blue and Red. Ten fountain pens, each with a different nib, plus a ballpen and a pencil tester. These Tester sets were supplied to dealers in the UK, allowing customers to test the different Parker 45 nibs to select their preference. The gripping sections imprinted "45" and the barrels nib size. These appear to all be mint as there are no signs of ink anywhere. The pens cannot be filled, only dipped. The barrels grooved with inlaid colors to differentiate then from pens to be sold. Extremely rare, this is the only complete 45 Tester Set known to survive. Similarly designed tester sets have been found for the Parker 51, 61 and 65, but only found in the UK. Most certainly designed and fabricated by Parker UK for their local dealers, or perhaps just to be used at trade shows. Ballpen and Pencil with brushed Lustraloy (stainless steel) caps. New-old-stock. Near mint in original Parker UK slotter box.






Featured - Vintage Wahl Eversharp Pens & Pencils - Featured

Charles Keeran's first mechanical pencil patent was in 1913. His pencils were first made by Heath (NJ). Moving to Chicago in 1915, he contracted the Wahl Adding Machine Co. to make Eversharp pencils. The following year Eversharp was absorbed into Wahl. In 1917 they acquired the Boston Fountain Pen Company, bringing Wahl into the fountain pen business. The branding of the pens and pencils remained separate until the late 1920's when it became Wahl-Eversharp. In 1941 Wahl was dropped from the name. In 1957 the Parker Pen Company acquired Wahl-Eversharp, discontinuing production a few years later. [Thank you Wikinedia]

Strauss bought the shaky Wahl Co. in 1939 and by the early 1940's, with its sponsorship of the radio show "Take it or Leave It," the phrase "The \$64 Question" and the Eversharp Pen Company were both known coast to coast. Strauss sold tens of millions of dollars of Skyline and Fifth Avenue pen and pencil sets. It's believed that the sets which have solid gold caps factory imprinted "6?4" (like this example) were not sold but were awarded as prizes on the radio show, and are extremely rare. Fine nib. 
